II. Location

The property address is 306 Park Avenue, Fort Lupton, Colorado.

III. Project Description

The applicant, First United Methodist Church of Fort Lupton (“Methodist Church”), has submitted a preliminary and primary application for designation of the Methodist Church building, which are attached to this report. Additional application documents not included in the application packet are available for review at City Hall.

IV. Findings/Conclusions

Upon receipt of an application for designation from a property owner, Section 18-343(c) of the Fort Lupton Municipal Code requires the Historic Preservation Board to schedule a public hearing by resolution on the question of designation (“designation hearing”). Therefore, the action the Board takes at this meeting is not to make a determination on whether or not the Methodist Church is eligible for designation, but to set the date, time and place for the designation hearing by resolution.

Because the Municipal Code requires the application be referred to the Planning Commission prior to the designation hearing, staff has determined that a hearing date before the Board on July 7, 2016 would provide sufficient time for the Planning Commission to review the application and provide a recommendation to the Board.

V. Board Alternatives/Options

1. The Board can approve the attached Resolution setting the hearing for designation on July 7, 2016 at 6:15 PM; or
2. The Board can deny the attached Resolution and schedule the hearing for a different date.

VI. Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of proposed Resolution No. H2016-01 to set the public hearing to consider designation of the First United Methodist Church of Fort Lupton for Thursday, July 7, 2016 at 6:15 PM.

- has character, interest or value as part of the development, heritage or cultural characteristics of the City, state or nation;
 - is the site of a historic event with an effect upon society;
 - is identified with a person or group of persons who had some influence on society; or
 - exemplifies the cultural, political, economic, social or historic heritage of the community.

Fort Lupton Mt United Methodist Church built in 1916 - dedicated Aug 1916 - Built on the corner NE of 3rd and Park -

- (2) **Architectural importance.** The site, structure, object or district
- portrays the environment of a group of people in an era of history characterized by a distinctive architectural style;
 - embodies those distinguishing characteristics of an architectural-type specimen; or
 - is the work of an architect or master builder whose individual work has influenced the development of the City; or contains elements of architectural design, detail, materials or craftsmanship which represent a significant innovation.

The building was built in 1916 by the Methodist Episcopal Church; the existing church at that time at 806 Denver Avenue was not large enough to hold the membership. The building is of the Romanesque Revival Style and is a prominent feature in Fort Lupton. 100 Year old this year, dedicated in August of 1916. Beginning in 1863 in Fort Lupton the Methodist Church has been active in all aspects of building Fort Lupton to be the town it now is.

The Methodist Episcopal Church began in Fort Lupton in 1863 meeting in people's homes then built a church in 1879 at 806 Denver Avenue, now the Erlinger Mortuary. In 1916 the property the SW corner of 3rd and Park was purchased for \$1,000.00 and a new bigger church was built. The cost of the building was \$16,000. This church was built in the Romanesque Revival Style with a watch tower/ belfry. The red brick on the bottom and sandstone color brick on the upper part makes for an impressive building. Many design attributes make the building a land mark for Fort Lupton. The stained glass windows by Watkins Stain glass in Denver were installed in 1916 also. Due to increased membership an addition was added in 1956. Careful attention was made to match the existing building in style and brick design. An Elevette was added to the NW corner of the building to make it handicap accessible in 1982.

As the building is a dominant feature in town, it is used as a landmark by many. When built many important city leaders were members ; Sandford David, Harry Ewing Sr., W.S. Decker, E.S. St. John, Rev. Saywell, Bowen Allsebrook, Wiley Burge, Rev. C.H. Brady and Rey St. John. You may recognize some of the names. See Picture.

The church is used for Sunday Church Service plus many meetings both church related and community related during the week. Many weddings and funerals are held there. The Fort Lupton First United Methodist Church presents a strong cultural significance in Fort Lupton. The Fort Lupton United Methodist Church is the 2nd oldest Methodist congregation in Colorado.
