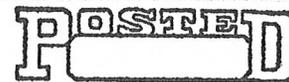

During the recent State inspection of the Water Treatment Plant it was noted that per the April 1, 2016 update of the Colorado Primary Drinking Water Act each filtration skid is required to have its own Turbidimeter and that a number of specific reporting and monitoring requirements go along with each Turbidimeter. In addition each of the existing turbidimeters were scheduled to be replaced during 2017. Per Sanitary Survey, the resolution date for installation of new turbidimeters is November 24, 2016. Staff has requested an extension to March 31, 2017 however as of this date no response has been received from CDPHE on extension request.

Failure to install the six new turbidimeters would be a violation of Regulation 11 and could cause an enforcement action to be levied against the city. Replacement of the additional units and would make sense to secure the best price possible from the manufacturer.

It was moved by Zoe Stieber and seconded by Bob McWilliams to award the purchase of new Turbidimeters for an amount not to exceed \$34,744.60 and award the contract to Browns Hill Engineering & Controls for an amount not to exceed \$35,867, allocated from the Water Fund.

Motion carried unanimously by a roll call vote.

AM 2016-0129, Authorize the City Administrator to Execute a One Year Addendum of the Windy Gap Lease for Five Units for an Amount of \$230,950 Plus Pass Thru Cost Funded From the Water Sales Tax Fund

The Council approved an Intergovernmental Agreement with Platte River Power Authority in 2012 to lease 10 units of Windy Gap to provide excess second use water for the city's needs. The original agreement included a three year water lease that was extendable. The City elected to execute a one year extension in 2015 for similar needs. At this time, the City desires to lease five units for another one year term to facilitate augmentation needs since the Perry Pit storage vessel will be unavailable during mining for 2017.

It was moved Chris Cross and seconded by Zoe Stieber to authorize the City Administrator to execute a one year extension to the Windy Gap Lease for five unite for an amount of \$230,950, plus pass thru cost allocated from the Water Sales Tax Fund. Motion carried unanimously by a roll call vote.

AM 2016-131, Tank Farm VFD Replacements

This request is to replace two 100 HP Variable Frequency Drives at the high pressure zone pump station. There will also be two communications PLC's needed to operate the drives and install two repeating radios. 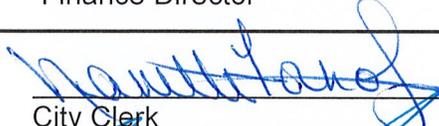

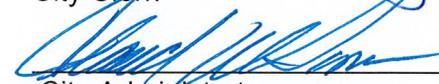

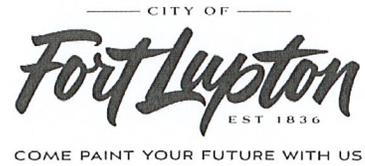

DEED OF PERPETUAL EASEMENT
(Water Line)

THIS DEED, made this 13th day of August, 2016, between Maxum Enterprises, LLC, doing business as Pilot Thomas Logistics, LLC, whose address is 201 Rupert Street, Fort Worth, TX 76107 ("Owner"), and the City of Fort Lupton located at 130 South McKinley Avenue, Fort Lupton, Colorado 80621 ("City").

That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements contained herein, the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration in hand paid by City to the Owner, the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, the Owner hereby grants, sells, and conveys to City, its successors and assigns an exclusive Perpetual Easement as described on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Perpetual Easement") to install, construct, operate, maintain, repair, reconstruct, replace, inspect, survey, and remove, at any time and from time to time, water and sewer lines including all improvements and appurtenances thereto (which is referred to herein as the "Improvements").

Owner further grants to City:

1. The right from time to time to enlarge, improve, reconstruct, relocate and replace any Improvement or other appurtenance constructed hereunder within the Perpetual Easement;
2. The right to ingress and egress over and across Owner's property for the purpose of exercising the rights herein granted;
3. The right to mark the location of the Perpetual Easement by suitable markers set in or on the ground; provided that permanent markers shall be placed in locations, which will not interfere with any reasonable use Owner shall make of said Perpetual Easement.

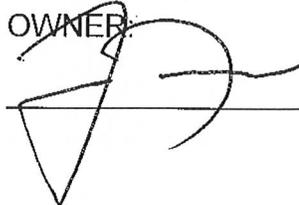

Any of the covenants herein contained shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their respective heirs, personal representatives, successors and assignees.

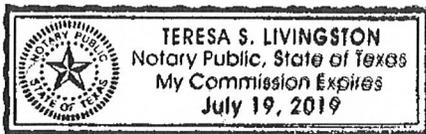

3. **TIME OF COMPLETION.** The Consultant agrees to commence work upon execution of this Agreement and to complete all work by no later than **November 1, 2016.**

4. **CONTRACT SUM.** The City shall pay to the Consultant for performance and completion of the work encompassed by this Agreement, and the Consultant will accept as full compensation therefore the sum of **\$33,800.00,** subject to confirmation by the City of completion of the scope of work in accordance with the contract documents attached hereto. Said amounts to be paid upon inspection and acceptance of the work by the City, in its sole discretion, including completion by the Consultant of any punch-list items as determined by the City and execution of any releases by Consultant deemed necessary by the City.

5. **CONTRACT APPROPRIATIONS/NO CHANGE ORDERS.** The City states that the amount of money appropriated for this Agreement is equal to or in excess of the contract amount. No change order to this Agreement requiring additional compensable work to be performed, which work causes the aggregate amount payable under this Agreement to exceed the amount appropriated for the original contract shall be issued by the City unless the City notifies the Consultant in writing, that lawful appropriations to

cover the costs of this additional work has been made.

6. **AMENDMENT/NO ASSIGNMENT.** No modification or amendment of this Agreement shall be valid unless in writing and signed by all parties to this Agreement.

7. **COMPLETE AGREEMENT.** This Agreement, and the exhibits hereto, shall constitute the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and there are no agreements, representations or warranties other than as set forth herein.
